Water Monitoring

The Stibnite Advisory Council's Independent Water Monitoring Program continued for the fourth year in a row to provide independently verified groundwater and surface water quality analyses from the Stibnite Project site.

2025 data analysis by Anatek Labs in Moscow, ID and SVL Analytical in Kellogg, ID showed consistent results with those collected and reported by Perpetua Resources.
